GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land within the east portion of Township 32 North, Range 37 East, is nearly level to gently rolling. The elevation ranges from about 4,450 to 5,000 ft. above sea level. The soil is clay loam. The vegetation consists of shadscale, budsage, greasewood and sparse native grasses. There is no timber.

No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.

Principal users of the area are cattlemen and access into the township is provided by desert roads.
