

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF THE EAST BOUNDARY, T. 33 N., R. 37 E.

CHAINS

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Over nearly level land; along a bladed road.

40.38 The cor. of Tps. 33 and 34 N., Rs. 37 and 38 E., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of T. 34 N., R. 38 E., executed under Group No. 427.

Land, nearly level.

Soil, clay loam.

Undergrowth, sagebrush, shadscale and greasewood.

Reestablishment of a Portion of the Survey Executed by

From the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, on the S. bdy. of the Tp.

N. 0° 49' W., bet. secs. 35 and 36.

Over gently rolling land, through medium undergrowth; desc. gradually over a gentle E. slope.

2.40 Creek, 10 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, course E.

22.00 Trail road, bears NE. and SW.

40.49 The ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 35 and 36, monumented with a wooden post, 2x2x30 ins., loosely set in a mound of earth between the 2 original pits, the outlines of which are visible.
