

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF A PORTION OF THE SUBDIVISIONAL LINES,
T. 33 N., R. 37 E.

CHAINS	
	At the corner point
	Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
	T33N R37E
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	1967
	set a steel fence post, 6 ft. long, 2 ft. in the ground, alongside the iron post.
	N. 2° 06' E., beginning new measurement.
	Over nearly level meadow land, along E. side of fence.
3.50	Leave meadow land, bears NNW. and SSE. Enter gently rolling land.
40.37	The cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, on the N. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of T. 34 N., R. 37 E., executed under Group No. 427.
	Land, nearly level meadow land to gently rolling.
	Soil, clay loam.
	Undergrowth, greasewood and saltgrass.
	From the cor. of secs. 34 and 35, on the S. bdy. of the Tp.
	N. 0° 13' E., bet. secs. 34 and 35.
	Over gently rolling land, through medium undergrowth; desc. a gradual NE. slope.
5.50	Trail road, bears NNE. and SSW.
21.40	Trail road, bears NE. and SW.
28.70	Wash, 10 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, drains NE.
39.87	The ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 34 and 35, monumented with the remains of a wooden post, loosely set in a mound of earth between the 2 original pits, the outlines of which are visible.
