40.31	<p>The cor. of secs. 2, 3, 10 and 11.</p> <p>Land, nearly level. Soil, clay loam. Undergrowth, greasewood and wild meadowgrass.</p>
40.30	<p>N. 1° 12' E., bet. secs. 2 and 3.</p> <p>Over nearly level land, through medium undergrowth.</p> <p>Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 2 and 3, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.</p> <p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">T33N R37E S 3 S 2 1967</p> <p>set a steel fence post, 6 ft. long, 2 ft. in the ground, alongside the iron post.</p>
80.35	Fence, bears NNW. and SSE.
80.97	<p>The cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34 and 35, on the N. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an iron post, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of T. 34 N., R. 37 E., executed under Group No. 427.</p> <p>Land, nearly level. Soil, clay loam. Undergrowth, shadscale, greasewood, rabbitbrush and saltgrass.</p>
	<p>From the cor. of secs. 33 and 34, on the S. bdy. of the Tp.</p> <p>N. 0° 10' E., bet. secs. 33 and 34.</p> <p>Desc. 70 ft. over an E. slope, through scattered juniper.</p>
7.00	Bottom of descent; asc. 110 ft. over a S. slope.
14.40	Spur, slopes E.; desc. 210 ft. over a N. slope.
30.30	Ravine, drains E.; asc. 60 ft. over a S. slope.
36.40	Spur, slopes E.; desc. 60 ft. over a N. slope.
40.14	Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 33 and 34, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.
