	<p style="text-align: center;">GENERAL DESCRIPTION</p> <p>The area resurveyed within Township 33 North, Range 37 East, varies from mountainous in the western portion to nearly level in the eastern portion. The western portion is in the East Mountain Range and the eastern portion in Grass Valley. The elevation ranges from about 4,400 to 6,000 ft. above sea level. The soil varies from sandy loam to clay loam including rocky portions on the higher elevations. The vegetation consists of sagebrush, shad-scale, greasewood, wild meadowgrass and other sparse native grasses. The timber consists of scattered juniper on the higher elevations.</p> <p>The township drains east-northeasterly into Grass Valley and all available water is used for irrigating purposes by the Great Western Land and Cattle Company (Grass Valley Ranch), located in secs. 13 and 24. There are wells located in secs. 11, 13, 22 and 24.</p> <p>No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the resurvey. Principal users of the area are cattlemen. Access is provided by a graveled road to the Great Western Land and Cattle Company Ranch and supplemented by numerous trail roads throughout the township.</p>
