

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF THE NORTH BOUNDARY, T. 11 N., R. 43 E.

CHAINS

39.43

Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 5 and 32, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Leave scattered silver buffaloberry bearing N. and S.; continue through greasewood and sagebrush.

49.50 Trail road, bears NNE. and SSW.

51.80 Bladed gravel road, parallels power line.

52.10 Power line, bears N. $20\frac{1}{2}^\circ$ E. and S. $20\frac{1}{2}^\circ$ W.

78.86 Point for the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Land, nearly level.

Soil, alkaline to sandy clay.

Undergrowth, silver buffaloberry, greasewood, sagebrush and ryegrass.

N. $89^\circ 32'$ W., bet. secs. 6 and 31.

Asc. 50 ft. over a gentle E. slope, through medium dense undergrowth to the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

1.70 Trail road, bears SSE. and NNW.

39.43 The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 6 and 31, monumented with a sharpened cottonwood post, 28 ins. long, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ins. square, bearing illegible scribe marks and lying on a dim mound of earth.
