and Bateman, U. S. Deputy Surveyors, in 1872.

From the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, on the S. bdy.
of the Tp., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam.,
set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the official
record.

N. 0° 21' W., bet. secs. 35 and 36.

Along a gentle W. slope, through scattered undergrowth.

10.70 Draw, drains WNW.

37.20 Wash, 10 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, drains W.

41.57 Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 35 and 36, at proport-
ionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the
original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 20 ins. in
the ground, with brass cap mkd.
