GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Township 15 North, Range 64 East, M.D.M., is situated
about 4 miles SSE. of Ely, Nevada. The elevation varies
from about 6450 to 7700 feet above sea level. The soil
varies from sandy clay in the lower elevations to gravelly
and rocky in the higher elevations.

The southern portion of the township is drained by numerous
washes draining into Comins Lake which is located in
sections 17 and 20. The remaining area is drained by
Steptoe Creek which flows westerly into section 17 and
then northerly through the township.

An abandoned mining operation is situated in sections 3,
10 and 11. No other mineral deposits of value were noted
during the course of the survey. The principal users of
the township are cattlemen. There is timber in the north-
eastern portion of the township consisting of scrub pinon
and juniper, of little commercial value.

U.S. Highway Nos. 6, 50 and 93, crosses the southwestern
portion of the township, entering on the south boundary
of section 34 and leaving the township on the west boundary
of section 6. Further access to the township is provided
by numerous secondary and desert trail roads.
