

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF THE EAST BOUNDARY, T. 4 N., R. 48 E.

CHAINS

43.00 Trail road, bears ENE. and WSW.

73.00 Top of ascent on W. slope; desc. gradually over a gentle W. slope.

74.50 Wash, 15 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, drains W.

81.18 Point for the cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
