81.18 Point for the cor. of Tps. 4 and 5 N., Rs. 48 and 49 E., at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
