

## DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF THE SUBDIVISIONAL LINES, T. 4 N., R. 48 E.

CHAINS

## GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land within Township 4 North, Range 48 East, is situated in Stone Cabin Valley. The terrain varies from nearly level in the central portion to low mountainous in the west portion. The remaining terrain is gently rolling. The elevation ranges from about 5,600 to 6,200 ft. above sea level. The soil is sandy to sandy clay loam and rocky on the higher elevations. The vegetation consists of shadscale, budsage, sagebrush, greasewood and sparse native grasses. There are a few cottonwood trees and willow thickets surrounding Stone Cabin Ranch, situated in section 8.

The area drains in a south-southeasterly direction through the central portion of the township. No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.

Access into the area is provided by U. S. Highway No. 6 crossing sections 33, 34, 35 and 36 in an east-northeasterly direction and two graded roads crossing the township in a north-northeasterly direction and supplemented by numerous trail roads. Principal users of the area are cattlemen.
