Reestablishment of a Portion of the Survey Executed by  
C. F. Putnam, U. S. Deputy Surveyor, in 1883.

From the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32, monumented with a granite stone, 23x7x4 ins., plainly mkd. with 5 grooves on the E. face, 1 groove on the W. face and firmly set in a mound of stone.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 3 ins. in the ground to underlying rock and in a mound of stone to top, 5 ft. base, with brass cap mkd.

N. 88° 58' W., bet. secs. 6 and 31.

Over gently rolling land, through medium undergrowth; desc. over a gradual W. slope.

- 0.80 Wash, 10 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, drains NW.; desc. 60 ft. over a gradual W. slope.
- 20.40 Wash, 15 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, drains irregularly NW.; desc. 70 ft. over a gradual W. slope.
- 40.87 Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 6 and 31, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
