

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF THE WEST BOUNDARY, T. 1 N., R. 46 E.

CHAINS

deposit broken glass alongside the iron post and raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor.

Continue over a gradual E. slope.

46.50 Base of spur, bears E. and W.; asc. 50 ft. over a S. slope.

54.50 Spur, slopes E.; desc. 100 ft. over a N. slope, changing to E.

79.84 Point for the cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

39.92 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.
