

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF THE S. BDY., T. 47 N., R. 64 E.

CHAINS

- 1.80 Small wash, drains ENE.; asc. 40 ft.
- 13.50 Bladed road, bears SSE. and NNW.; asc. 100 ft. over an E. slope.
- 33.50 Bladed road, bears SSE. and NNW.; asc. 70 ft. over an E. slope.
- 40.05 The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 6 and 31, monumented with a basalt stone, 14x12x6 ins., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ on the N. face and firmly set in a circle of stone.
- At the corner point
- Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 14 ins. in the ground to underlying rock, and in a mound of stone, $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.

- 19.00 Spur, slopes N., desc. 100 ft. over NW. slope.
- 22.50 Draw, drains NE. 4.00 chs. dist., thence E.; asc. 370 ft. over a broken E. slope.
- 39.85 The cor. of Tps. 46 and 47 N., Rs. 63 and 64 E., monumented with an iron post, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of T. 46 N., R. 63 E., surveyed concurrently under this same group.
- Land, high rolling.
 Soil, rocky.
 Undergrowth, sagebrush and desert grasses.
