

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF THE E. BDY., T. 47 N., R. 64 E.

CHAINS

N. 0° 37' E., beginning new measurement.

Over gently rolling land, through medium undergrowth.

14.00 Bladed road, bears NE. and SW.

29.95 The closing corner of secs. 1 and 6 on the Nevada-Idaho State Boundary, monumented with a basalt stone, 16x14x8 ins., mkd. with 6 notches on the E. edge, and 6 notches on the W. edge and CC on the S. face, firmly set in a mound of stone.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 16 ins. in the ground to underlying rock, and in a mound of stone, 4 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.

From this corner, the 32nd Mile post on the Idaho-Nevada State Boundary, bears N. 88° 36' W., 24.21 chs. dist.

Land, gently rolling.

Soil, sandy clay and rocky.

Undergrowth, sagebrush and crested wheat grass.

Over high rolling land, through medium undergrowth; desc. 350 ft. over a N. slope.

17.30 Small wash, drains ENE. asc. 20 ft.

20.00 Desc. 170 ft. over a NE. slope.

40.16 The ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 31 and 36, monumented with a squared wooden post, 24 ins. long, 1½ ins. square, loosely set in a small mound of earth and dimly mkd. ¼.
