Soil, rocky Undergrowth, sagebrush and desert grasses.</p> <hr/> <p>N. 0° 13' E., bet. secs. 2 and 3.</p> <p>Over broken land, through medium undergrowth; desc. 60 ft. over a W. slope.</p> <p>10.60 Small wash, drains NW.; desc. 50 ft. along a W. slope.</p> <p>21.50 Draw, drains SW.</p> <p>21.90 Trail road, bears NE. and SW.; asc. 150 ft. over a S. slope.</p> <p>41.32 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 2 and 3, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.</p> <p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 12 ins. in the ground to underlying rock and in a mound of stone, 4 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">T47N R64E $\frac{1}{4}$ S 3 S 2 1968</p> <p>Asc. 50 ft. over a S. slope.</p> <p>52.00 Trail road, bears NNE. and SSW.; desc. 70 ft. over a N. slope.</p> <p>77.40 Fence, bears E. and W.</p> <p>77.40 The closing corner of secs. 2 and 3, on the Idaho-Nevada State Boundary Line, monumented with an unmarked basalt stone, 18x16x12 ins., firmly set in a large mound of stone.</p> <p>At the corner point</p> <p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 8 ins. in the ground to underlying rock and in a mound of stone, 4 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">I D A S 3 S 2 T47N R64E C C NEV 1968</p> <p>bury the unmarked stone alongside the iron post.</p>
