

TOWNSHIP 7 NORTH, RANGE 26 EAST

CHAINS

The geographic position for the cor. of Tps. 6 and 7 N., Rs. 26 and 27 E. is at latitude 38° 24' 52.6" N. and longitude 119° 00' 55.0" W., as adjusted along section lines from U.S.G.S. triangulation station "CHET" 1955.

The mean magnetic declination was found to be 17° East.

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF A PORTION OF THE SOUTH BOUNDARY
T. 7 N., R. 26 E., MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA

Reestablishment of a Portion of the Survey Executed by
R. A. Chase, U. S. Deputy Surveyor, in 1870.

The cor. of Tps. 6 and 7 N., Rs. 26 and 27 E., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., set, marked and witnessed as described in the field note record of the south boundary of T. 7 N., R. 27 E., resurveyed concurrently under this same group.

The corner is located in a saddle bearing N. and S.

N. 89° 47' W., bet. secs. 1, and 36.

Over rolling land, through scattering timber and medium brush; desc. 80 ft. over a SW. slope.

15.20 Wash, 10 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, drains NW.; desc. 120 ft. over a N. slope.

17.30 Trail road, bears NW. and SE.

30.40 Same wash, 10 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, drains S., curving W.; desc. 30 ft. over a W. slope.

36.00 Same wash, 10 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, drains NW.

40.41 The ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 36, monumented with a trapstone, 8x8x3 ins., plainly mkd. ¼ on the N. face and firmly set in a mound of stone.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 12 ins. in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone to top, 4 ft. base, with brass cap mkd.
