Vegetation, shadscale and budsage.</p> <hr style="border: 0.5px solid black;"/> <p style="text-align: center;">GENERAL DESCRIPTION</p> <p>The area surveyed and resurveyed within Township 7 North, Range 27 East, is located in the foothills along the East Walker River which crosses this portion of the township in an easterly direction. The elevation ranges from about 5,600 to 6,100 ft. above sea level. The soil varies from rocky clay on the higher country to sandy clay loam along the river bottom. The vegetation consists of shadscale, budsage, sagebrush, willow, buckthorn and sparse native grasses. There are scattered stands of pinon and cedar along the south boundary of the township.</p> <p>There are no improvements in this portion of the township. No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.</p> <p>Access into the area is provided by a graded dirt road which joins State Highway No. 22 about 5 miles to the west.
