	<p>At the corner point</p> <p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 21 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p> <div><div>T7N R27E</div><div>½</div><div>S 3</div></div> <p>1969</p> <p>bury the original corner stone alongside the iron post and raise a mound of stone, 4 ft. base, 3 ft. high, E. of cor.</p> <hr/> <p>N. 1° 10' W., beginning new measurement.</p> <p>Descend 70 ft. over a NW. slope, changing to a broken W. slope.</p> <p>13.20 Head of wash, drains W.; asc. 240 ft. over a S. slope.</p> <p>20.00 Spur, slopes SW.; desc. 90 ft. along broken W. slope.</p> <p>41.46 The cor. of secs. 3, 4, 33 and 34, on the N. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field note record of the south boundary of T. 8 N., R. 27 E., resurveyed concurrently under this same group.</p> <p>Land, mountainous. Soil, rocky clay. Vegetation, budsage and shadscale.</p> <hr/> <p>From the cor. of secs. 4, 5, 32 and 33, on the S. bdy. of the Tp.</p> <p>N. 0° 18' W., bet. secs. 32 and 33.</p> <p>Over mountainous land, through light brush; desc. 130 ft. over a N. slope.</p> <p>5.10 Rough Creek, 40 lks. wide, course W.; asc. 460 ft. over a broken S. slope.</p> <p>40.61 The ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 32 and 33, monumented with a granite stone, 15x8x3 ins., mkd. ¼ on the W. face, firmly set in a small mound of stone.</p>
