T. 7 N., R. 27 E.

CHAINS	
	Land, rolling. Soil, rocky clay. Timber, pinon and cedar. Vegetation, budsage and shadscale.
	From the cor. of secs. 4, 5, 8 and 9.  N. 0° 19' E., bet. secs.. 4 and 5.  Over mountainous land, through light brush; asc. 50 ft. over a SE. slope.
4.60	Spur, slopes E.; desc. 220 ft. over a NE. slope.
20.70	Right bank of East Walker River, bears E. and W.; thence across river, course E.
21.70	Left bank of East Walker River; asc. 420 ft. over a S. slope.
40.34	Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 4 and 5, at propor- tionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.  Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 6 ins. in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone to top, 6 ft. base, with brass cap mkd.  T7N R27E $\frac{1}{4}$ S 5   S 4  1969  Ascend 390 ft. over a S. slope.
49.60	Ridge, bears ENE. and WSW.; desc. 490 ft. over a N. slope.
74.40	Ravine, drains E.; asc. 310 ft. over a SW. slope.
83.56	The cor. of secs. 4, 5, 32 and 33, on the N. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an iron post, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field note record of the south boundary of T. 8 N., R. 27 E., resurveyed concurrently under this same group.  Land, mountainous. Soil, rocky clay. Vegetation, budsage and shadscale.
	From the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32, on the S. bdy. of the Tp.  N. 0° 08' W., bet. secs. 31 and 32.  Over mountainous land, through light brush; desc. 10 ft. over a N. slope.
