GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The area resurveyed within Township 7 North, Range 27 East, is located in mountainous terrain along the East Walker River which enters the township in section 30, flowing in a northerly direction and leaving the township through section 4. Rough Creek and a number of other drainages empty into the East Walker River. The elevations range from about 5,600 to 6,800 ft. above sea level. The soil is mainly rocky clay with some sandy clay loam along the river. The vegetation consists of budsage, shadscale, sagebrush, willow and sparse native grasses. There are scattering stands of pinon and cedar throughout the northern portion of the township.

The old Ravenelle Ranch located in section 30 which is owned by the Flying M Ranch is the only improvement in the township. There is a mineral hot spring located in the W_2^1 of the SW_3^1 of section 4. No other mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.

Access into the area is provided by a graded dirt road entering the township in section 31 which joins State Highway No. 22 about 6 miles to the west. Several trail roads branch from the dirt road, extending into the northern portion of the township.
