

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF A PORTION OF THE SUBDIVISIONAL LINES  
T. 8 N., R. 27 E.

<p>CHAINS</p>	<p>GENERAL DESCRIPTION</p> <p>The area resurveyed within Township 8 North, Range 27 East, is located in mountainous terrain along the East Walker River which enters the township in section 33, flowing in a northerly direction and leaving the township through section 6. The elevations range from about 5,000 to 6,500 ft. above sea level. The soil is mainly rocky clay with sandy clay loam along the river. The vegetation consists of sagebrush, shadscale, budsage, willow and sparse native grasses. There are scattering stands of pinon and cedar in the southwestern portion of the township</p> <p>There are several small ranches along the river located in sections 8, 9, 15, 22 and 33. No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.</p> <p>Access into the area is provided by a graded dirt road entering the township in section 6 which comes from Yerington, Nevada, with several trail roads branching from it into other portions of the township.</p>	
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
