raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor.

N. 89° 36' W., bet. secs. 5 and 32.

Over nearly level land draining N., through a reseeded area.

40.49 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 5 and 32, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
