<p>GENERAL DESCRIPTION</p>	
<p>Township 42 North, Range 21 East, Mount Diablo Meridian, Nevada, is situated in northwestern Nevada, about 14 miles east of Vya, Nevada. Access is provided by Nevada State Route 8A and numerous track and trail roads.</p>	
<p>There are mountains throughout the area other than portions of the northern tier of sections. Elevations range from 5600 to 7000 feet above sea level. The soil is comprised of clay sand with alluvial debris. Vegetation consists of scattered mahogany trees along the high ridges and sagebrush throughout the township. A good supply of grasses is available in most of the area.</p>	
<p>There are numerous small springs at scattered locations providing some stockwater. No mineral resources of value were noted. There are no residents in the township however there is a line cabin situated in section 14 at the site of the original Massacre Ranch. Principal users of the area are stockmen.</p>
