## GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Township 43 North, Range 21 East, Mount Diablo Meridian, Nevada, is situated in northwestern Nevada about 15 miles ENE. of Vya, Nevada. Access is provided by Nevada State Route 8A and numerous minor track and trail roads.

There are mountains along the eastern tier of sections and several low hills in scattered locations throughout the area. There are three major lakes in the township including West Lake, Middle Lake and Massacre Lake. These are shallow fresh water lakes that dry up during portions of dry years. During the course of the resurvey all were water filled at one time or another and all were essentially dry also.

There has been extensive range improvement reseeding in the southern and northwestern portions of the township. Stockwater windmills are situated in sections 8, 11 and 34. No mineral resources of value were noted during the resurvey.

There are scattered juniper trees in the northwestern sections. Brush ranging from sagebrush at high elevations through greasewood and rabbitbrush near the lakes, is common throughout the township except where reseeding has been done.

There are no residents in the township and principal users currently are stockmen.
