- Over rolling mountainous land; asc. 90 ft. along S. slope.
- 57.00 Ravine, drains SW.; asc. 250 ft. over NW. slope.
- 80.00 Point for the cor. of secs. 35 and 36.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 8 ins. in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone to cap, 4 ft. base, with brass cap mkd.
