

## SURVEY OF THE SUBDIVISIONAL LINES OF T. 15 N., R. 56 E.

CHAINS

From this corner the standard cor. of sec. 31, T. 16 N., R. 56 E., heretofore described, bears EAST, 4.26 chs. dist.

## GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land within Township 15 North, Range 56 East ranges from about 6000 to 7600 ft. above sea level, and is nearly level to rolling and mountainous. The soil is sandy clay, gravel and rocky. The vegetation consists of sagebrush, greasewood, whitesage and native grass, in the lower elevations and juniper and pinon on the higher elevations.

The township is drained by Bull Creek, which winds south through the eastern portion of the township.

No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.

Principal users of the area are cattlemen. Access into the township is provided by desert trail roads throughout the township.
