66.80	Spur, slopes ESE.; desc. 100 ft. along E. slope.
80.00	Point for the cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12. Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 20 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd. <div style="text-align: center;"> T29N R68E R69E S 1 S 6 S 12 S 7 </div> 1969 raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor. Land, rolling. Soil, sandy clay and gravel. Timber, juniper and pinon. Undergrowth, sagebrush and greasewood.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 18 ins. in the ground to bedrock and in a collar of stone to cap, 3 ft. base, with brass cap mkd. <div style="text-align: center;"> T29N R68E R69E ¼ S 1 S 6 </div> 1969 Desc. 220 ft. over NE. slope to ravine.
53.60	Head of ravine, drains E.; asc. 210 ft. over S. slope.
76.90	Spur, slopes E.; desc. 20 ft. over N. slope.
80.00	Point for the cor. of Tps. 29 and 30 N., Rs. 68 and 69 E.
