This Independent Resurvey supersedes the Survey Executed by Preble and Thorburn, U.S. Deputy Surveyors, in 1881. No corners of the original survey were found.

From the cor. of Tps. 29 and 30 N., Rs. 69 and 70 E., monumented with an iron post, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of the independent resurvey of T. 29 N., R. 69 E., surveyed concurrently under this same group.

EAST, bet. secs. 6 and 31.

Over rolling land, through scattered undergrowth.

40.00 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 6 and 31.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
