This Independent Resurvey supersedes the Survey Executed by Preble and Thorburn, U.S. Deputy Surveyors, in 1882. No corners of the original survey were found.

From the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32, on the S. bdy. of the Tp.

N. 0° 01' E., bet. secs. 31 and 32.

Over gently rolling land, through scattered undergrowth.

3.00 Bladed road, bears ENE. and WSW.

40.00 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 31 and 32.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor.

Land, gently rolling.

Soil, sandy clay and gravel.

Undergrowth, sagebrush and greasewood.

From the cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, on the W. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an iron post, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of the independent resurvey of the east boundary of T. 29 N., R. 69 E., surveyed concurrently under this same group.

EAST, bet. secs. 30 and 31.

Over rolling land, through scattered undergrowth.
