47.14	<p>Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 2, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.</p> <p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">T40N R46E $\frac{1}{4}$ S 2 S 1</p> <p style="text-align: center;">1970</p> <p>raise a mound of stone, 4 ft. base, 3 ft. high, W. of cor. Continue over gently rolling land.</p>

151.70	Wash, 20 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, drains WNW.

181.70	<p>Intersect the Eighth Standard Parallel North.</p> <p>The closing cor. of secs. 1 and 2, monumented with a badly deteriorated wooden post, with dim illegible scribe marks and loosely set in a mound of stone.</p> <p>At the corner point</p> <p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">T41N R47E S 32 S 2 S 1 CC T40N R46E</p> <p style="text-align: center;">1970</p> <p>bury the remains of the wooden post alongside the iron post and raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, S. of cor.</p> <p>From this corner, the standard $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 32, T. 41 N., R. 47 E., bears N. $89^{\circ} 25'$ E., 17.82 chs. dist., monumented with an iron post, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of the resurvey of the Eighth Standard Parallel North, through Range 47 East.</p>
