

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF THE EAST BOUNDARY OF

CHAINS  
74.68

The cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, monumented with a limestone, 16x10x10 ins., dimly mkd. with 5 grooves on the S. face and 2 grooves on the N. face, and firmly set in a mound of stone.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 6 ins. in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone, 4 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.

Over rolling mountainous land, through scattered sagebrush and native grass; asc. 130 ft. over S. slope.

- 20.10 Draw, drains WSW.; asc. 200 ft. over S. slope.
- 38.70 Ridge, bears E. and W.; desc. 130 ft. over N. slope.
- 54.08 Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6, at proportionate dist.; there is no remaining evidence of the original cor.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 8 ins. in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone, 4 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.
