

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF THE SUBDIVISIONAL LINES OF
T. 40 N., R. 48 E.

CHAINS	
131.00	Low spur, slopes SSE.; desc. 50 ft. along rolling E. slope.
149.80	Ravine, drains SE.; asc. 390 ft. over SW. slope.
188.00	Ridge, bears NNW. and SSE.; desc. 50 ft. along E. slope.
199.32	Intersect the Eighth Standard Parallel North.

Point for the closing cor. of secs. 2 and 3, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

From this corner the standard ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 31, T. 41 N., R. 49 E., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of the Eighth Standard Parallel North, through a portion of R. 49 E., resurveyed concurrently under this same group, bears N. 89° 54' E., 16.70 chs. dist.

Point for the N. ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 2, is on the Eighth Standard Parallel North and at midpoint on the N. bdy. of sec. 2.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
