

SURVEY OF THE EAST AND WEST BOUNDARIES OF SECTION 2, TOWNSHIP 15 NORTH, RANGE 70 EAST

CHAINS

Beginning at the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 11 and 12, monument-
ed with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., set, mkd. and
witnessed as described in the official record.

N. 0° 01' W., bet. secs. 1 and 2.

Over rolling land, through scattered undergrowth; desc.
400 ft. over N. slope.

25.73 Intersect the Third Standard Parallel North, as deter-
mined from geographic position based on U.S.F.S. third
order electronic traverse data, at a point EAST of the
standard cor. of Tps. 16 N., Rs. 69 and 70 E. which is
monumented with an iron post, 3 ins. diam., set, mkd.
and witnessed as described in the official record.

Point for the closing cor. of secs. 1 and 2.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 10 ins. in
the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone to cap, 4
ft. base, with brass cap mkd.

N. 0° 01' W., bet. secs. 2 and 3.

Over rolling land, through scattered undergrowth; asc.
70 ft. along rolling E. slope.

15.30 Spur, slopes E., fence along spur, bears SE. and NW.;
desc. 20 ft. over NE. slope.

25.64 Intersect the Third Standard Parallel North.
