

SURVEY OF CERTAIN SUBDIVISIONAL LINES OF  
T. 16 N., R. 70 E.

CHAINS

Raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor.

Desc. 800 ft. over N. slope.

59.50 Little Horse Canyon, drains E.; asc. 200 ft. over S. slope.

73.30 Spur, slopes E.; desc. 160 ft. over N. slope.

80.00 Point for the cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34 and 35, on the N. bdy. of the Tp.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., on bedrock over a cross (X) and in a mound of stone to cap, 4 ft. base, with brass cap mkd.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The lines surveyed in Township 16 North, Range 70 East, are situated along the east side of Mt. Moriah. The elevation varies from about 6400 to 7600 feet above sea level. The soil is sandy clay and rocky. The vegetation consists of sagebrush and greasewood. There is timber on the higher elevations consisting of juniper and pinon.

The area is drained easterly by Hendrys Creek, in sections 34 and 35, Hampton Creek, in sections 14 and 15, and Little Horse Canyon, in sections 2 and 3.

Access into the area is provided by numerous trail roads. The major use of the area is grazing. There are no residents.
