CHAINS

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., on bedrock over a cross (X) and in a mound of stone to cap, 4 ft. base, with brass cap mkd.

40.00 True point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 3 and 4, falls on ledge, sloping E. Mkd. an X, 16 ins. long on the face of ledge at the corner point.

Desc. 170 ft. over broken N. slope.

47.20 Ledge, bears NW. and SE., 60 ft. high; desc. 400 ft. over N. slope.

73.70 Enter rolling land; desc. 110 ft. over NE. slope.

79.43 Point for the cor. of secs. 3 and 4, on the N. bdy. of T. 17 N., R. 70 E., at a point EAST of the cor. of Tps. 17 and 18 N., Rs. 68 and 69 E., monumented with an iron post, 3 ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 20 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
