

Dependent Resurvey, Portion of E. Bdy., T. 5 N., R. 41 E.

CHAINS

N. 0° 10' E., beginning new measurement.

Ascend 10 ft. along rolling W. slope.

28.48 Point for the 1/16 80 sec. cor. of sec. 6 only, T. 5 N., R. 42 E., hereinafter described.

Ascend 5 ft. along rolling W. slope.

40.16 Intersect the First Stan. Par. N., at the closing cor. of secs. 1 and 6, described in the field notes of the concurrent resurvey of a portion of the First Stan. Par. N., S. bdy. of T. 6 N., R. 42 E.

From this point the standard cor. of Tps. 6 N., Rs. 41 and 42 E., bears N. 89° 15' W., 2.91 chs. distance.

Land, rolling desert.

Soil, sandy loam.

No timber; vegetation consists of sagebrush, greasewood, and rabbitbrush.

Survey of a Portion of the S. Bdy. of
T. 5 N., R. 42 E., Mt. Diablo Meridian, Nevada

From the original cor. of Tps. 4 and 5 N., Rs. 42 and 43 E., monumented with a lava stone, 10 x 13 x 18 ins., set in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2½ ft. high, marked with 6 grooves on the N., S., E., and W. faces.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 15 ins. in the ground, to bedrock, and in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, to top, with brass cap mkd.

Deposit original stone alongside the iron post.

Raise a mound of stone, 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high,
S. of the corner.

West, on the S. bdy. of sec. 36.

Descend 5 ft. over broken SE. slope, through scattering sagebrush.

5.70 Dry wash, drains S. 30° E.; asc. 80 ft. over SE. slope.

16.15 Spur, slopes S. 20° W.; desc. 60 ft. over SW. slope.

26.10 Dry wash, drains S. 50° E.; asc. 50 ft. over NE. slope.

40.00 Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 36 only.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 16 ins. in the ground, to bedrock, and in a mound of stone, 2½ ft. base, to top, with brass cap mkd.
