Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky and sandy loam.

No timber; vegetation consists of sagebrush, greasewood, and rabbitbrush.

N. 89° 24' W., on the S. bdy. of sec. 31.

Descend 20 ft. over W. slope.

- 2.00 Foot of the San Antonio Mountains, bears generally N. and S.; desc. 120 ft. over gradual W. slope.
- 3.70 Dirt road, 15 lks. wide, bears N. 30° W. and S. 30° E.
- 30.30 Dirt road, 15 lks. wide, bears N. 75° W. and S. 75° E.
- 32.45 Point for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of sec. 6 only, on the N. bdy. of T. 5 N., R. 42 E., described in the field notes of the concurrent survey of a portion of the subdivisinal lines, T. 5 N., R. 42 E.
- Descend 5 ft. over gradual W. slope.
- 34.70 The original standard  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of sec. 31, monumented with a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1 ft. high, alongside of which is a squared post, 4 x 4 ins., firmly set, protruding 36 ins. above the ground.
- At the corner point
- Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 23 ins. in the ground, and in a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, to top, with brass cap mkd.

- Raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, N. of the corner.
- N. 89° 15' W., beginning new measurement.
- Descend 120 ft. over gradual W. slope, along the S. side of a dirt road, 15 lks. wide, bears generally E. and W.
- 37.33 The original closing cor. of Tps. 5 N., Rs. 41 and 42 E., monumented with an iron pipe, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., of which I have no record, firmly set, protruding 36 ins. above the ground, in a mound of stone, 4 ft. base, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high, alongside of which is a squared post, 4 x 4 ins., firmly set, protruding 36 ins. above the ground.

- Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
