	<p>From the SE. corner of section 19 only, determined at record distance in latitude from the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31, and 32, on the N. bdy. of the Tp., and at record distance in departure from the cor. of secs. 19, 24, 25, and 30, on the W. bdy. of the Tp.; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.</p> <p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 21 ins. in the ground, and in a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, to top, with brass cap mkd.</p> <div style="text-align: center;"> <table border="1"> <tr><td>T 6 N</td></tr> <tr><td>R 42 E</td></tr> <tr><td>S 19</td></tr> <tr><td>S 30</td></tr> </table> <p>1970</p> </div> <p>Set a steel fence post, 5 ft. long, alongside the iron post.</p> <p>Raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, NW. of the corner.</p> <p>From this point the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31, and 32, on the N. bdy. of the Tp., bears N. 0° 47' E., 320.59 chs. dist.
