	<p>Over gently rolling land, through shadscale, sagebrush and greasewood.</p>

14.66	The closing cor. of Tps. 5 N., Rs. 60 and 61 E., herein- after described.
	Over rolling land.
40.98	Point for the standard ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 36, at propor- tionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.
	Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

	set a steel fence post, 5½ ft. long, 2½ ft. in the ground, alongside the iron post.

81.96	The standard cor. of secs. 35 and 36, monumented with a cedar post, 2x2x6 ins., loosely set in a mound of earth and dimly scribed.
