Reestablishment of the Survey Executed by
E. B. Monroe and A. G. Bateman, U. S. Deputy Surveyors,
in 1871.

From the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, on the S. bdy.
of the Tp., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam.,
set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes
of T. 4 N., R. 60 E., concurrently resurveyed under this
same Group.

N. 0° 52' E., bet. secs. 35 and 36.

Over nearly level land, through shadscale and sagebrush.

39.83 Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 35 and 36, at propor-
tionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the
original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins.
in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
