	39.30	<p>From the cor. of secs. 3, 4, 33 and 34, on the S. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of T. 4 N., R. 60 E., concurrently resurveyed under this same Group.</p> <p>N. 0° 17' E., bet. secs. 33 and 34.</p> <p>Over nearly level land, through sagebrush and shadscale.</p> <p>Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 33 and 34, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.</p> <p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">T5N R60E           ¼ S 33   S 34</p> <p style="text-align: center;">1970</p> <p>set a steel fence post, 5½ ft. long, 2½ ft. in the ground, alongside the iron post.</p>
