## DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF A PORTION OF THE SUBDIVISIONAL LINES T. 5 N., R. 60 E.

## GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land resurveyed within Township 5 North, Range 60 East, is nearly level. The elevation ranges from about 5,100 to 5,190 ft. above sea level. The soil consists of sandy clay and sandy gravel. The vegetation consists of sagebrush, shadscale, budsage, greasewood, rabbit-brush and saltgrass.

The township is drained by the White River that crosses through the east part of the township in a southerly direction. Tule Field Reservoir is located in secs. 1 and 12; this reservoir provides good fishing and water fowl hunting. The old dam of Whipple Reservoir is located on the section line between secs. 23 and 24.

No mineral formations of consequence were noted during this survey.

Principal users of the area are cattlemen, sheepmen and sportsmen; there are several bands of wild horses in the area. Access into the township is provided by graded gravel roads and trail roads.
