	<p>From the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 7 and 8.</p> <p>N. <math>0^{\circ} 03' W.</math>, bet. secs. 5 and 6.</p> <p>Over nearly level land, through medium undergrowth.</p>
40.00	<p>Point for the <math>\frac{1}{4}</math> sec. cor. of secs. 5 and 6.</p> <p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, <math>2\frac{1}{2}</math> ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p> <div><div>T6N R62E</div><div><math>\frac{1}{4}</math></div><div>S 6   S 5</div><div>1970</div></div> <p>set a steel fence post, <math>5\frac{1}{2}</math> ft. long, <math>2\frac{1}{2}</math> ft. in the ground, alongside the iron post.</p>

	<p>Point for the N. <math>\frac{1}{4}</math> sec. cor. of sec. 5, is on the S. bdy. of sec. 32, T. 7 N., R. 62 E., and at midpoint on the N. bdy. of sec. 5.</p>
