

## RETRACEMENT OF A PORTION OF THE NEVADA-CALIFORNIA STATE LINE

CHAINS	
	S. 0° 51' W., along the 151st mile.
	Over mountainous land, through scattered to medium dense juniper and mahogany with sagebrush.
2.50	Shallow draw, drains W.
6.70	Fence, bears N. 86½° E. and S. 86½° W. along low spur which slopes SW. from E.; desc. 50 ft. over broken S. slope.
11.50	Razorback rock outcropping, bears S. from this point; desc. 150 ft. over broken S. slope.
18.20	Sharp walled ravine, drains W.; asc. 270 ft. over steep N. slope.
24.60	Sharp rocky spur, slopes NW.; desc. 100 ft. over SW. slope.
31.00	Ravine, drains W.; asc. 20 ft. over NW. slope.
31.50	Bladed road, bears SE. and NW.; a mine tunnel portal bears N. 44° E., 1.20 chs. dist. The tunnel bears NE. from the portal. Along rolling W. slope.
34.60	Road, bears E. and W.
35.00	Ravine, drains NW.
36.00	Road, bears E. and W.
37.50	Road, bears E. and W.
50.00	Spur, slopes NW.; desc. 260 ft. over SW. slope.
67.40	Wash, 10 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, drains W.; along W. slope.
72.00	Wash, 10 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, drains NW.; asc. 40 ft. over gentle NNE. slope.
75.69	The Nevada closing cor. of Tps. 22 and 23 N., R. 18 E.; hereinafter described.
81.41	<p>The 151st Mi. cor., Nevada-California State Line, monumented with a sawed pine post, 5 ins. square, 4 ft. long, lying loose on the ground, with one end charred, mkd. NEV on one side, the other 3 sides being too rotten to determine any visible scribe marks, and from which the remains of an original bearing tree:</p>
	<p>A juniper, 30 ins. diam., bears N. 65° W., 490 lks. dist. (slope measurement, as confirmed on bearing tree ties for Mi. Cor. 150). The stump is 4 ft. high and has been burned hollow. The E. face bears a blaze and overgrowth with portions of illegible scribe marks. (record bearing WEST).</p>
