## CHAINS

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF THE SOUTH BOUNDARY,  
T. 23 N., R. 18 E., MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA.

Reestablishment of the Survey Executed by  
A. J. Hatch, Deputy Surveyor,  
in 1867,  
a Portion of which was Retraced by  
T. K. Stewart, Deputy Surveyor,  
in 1900.

The Stewart retracement is obviously fraudulent due to his reporting recovery of the closing township corner that he was in fact to have, at that time, monumented with the original monument for that corner. He also failed to identify the Von Schmidt mile corners as mile corners but instead the plat indicated they were corners common with subdivisional lines of the California surveys. Based on these reasons, the Stewart retracement of a portion of this boundary and the tie he gave to what apparently was to have been Mi. Cor. 151, are disregarded in the proportionate reestablishment of the missing corners of that portion of this boundary.

The cor. of Tps. 22 and 23 N., Rs. 18 and 19 E., monumented with an iron post, 3 ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 12 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the official record of the 1914 resurvey, with a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, S. of cor.

S. 89° 34' W., bet. secs. 1 and 36.

Over gently rolling land, through harrowed range land, diverging to the N. from an E.-W. fence.

7.00 Swale, drains NE.; asc. 30 ft. over E. slope.

27.90 Trail road, bears N. and S.
