	<p>The land within Township 36 North, Range 43 East, is nearly level. The elevation ranges from about 4,400 to 4,490 ft. above sea level. The soil varies from sandy clay to sandy loam. The vegetation consists of grease-wood, shadscale, sagebrush and native grasses. The township drains in a westerly direction.</p>
	<p>No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.</p>
	<p>Principal users of the area are cattlemen. Access is provided by several trail roads through the township.</p>
