Point for the closing cor. of Tps. 38 and 39 N.,
R. 50 E., on the W. bdy. of T. 38 N., R. 51 E., and on
the S. bdy. of the Tp.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins.
in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

From this corner, the cor. of secs. 18 and 19, T. 38 N.,
R. 51 E., monumented with a granite stone, 14x6x6 ins.,
firmly set 8 ins. in the ground, mkd. with 3 grooves on
the N. and S. faces, with a mound of stone E., bears S.
 $0^{\circ} 25' W.$, 158.99 chs. dist. This control line was
retraced and a diligent search was made for the inter-
vening cors., but none were found.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins.
in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

deposit the original cornerstone and set a steel fence
post, 6 ft. long, alongside the iron post and raise a
mound of stone, 4 ft. base, 3 ft. high, E. of cor.

From the closing corner, the original closing cor. of
Tps. 38 and 39 N., R. 50 E., monumented with a basalt
stone, 16x12x6 ins., firmly set 10 ins. in the ground,
mkd. with 6 grooves on the N., S., E. and W. faces, bears
S. $89^{\circ} 42' E.$, 0.22 chs. dist. This corner mkd. with
the letters AM for amended monument and buried.

N. $0^{\circ} 25' E.$, along the W. bdy. of sec. 7.

Over rolling land, covered with bunchgrass and sagebrush;
asc. 170 ft. over E. slope.
