

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF A PORTION OF THE SUBDIVISIONAL LINES,
T. 39 N., R. 50 E., MDM, NEVADA

<p>CHAINS 63.00</p> <p>69.00</p> <p>80.40</p>	<p>Trail road on spur, sloping E., trail road bears E. and W.; desc. 40 ft. over NNE. slope.</p> <p>Creek, 10 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, course SSE.; asc. 210 ft. over WSW. slope.</p> <p>The cor. of secs. 3, 4, 33 and 34, on the N. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., firmly set, showing 6 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd. and witnessed as described in the field note record of T. 40 N., R. 50 E., resurveyed concurrently under this same group.</p> <hr/> <p>The cor. of secs. 28, 29, 32 and 33, monumented with a limestone, 14x12x6 ins., firmly set in a mound of stone, mkd. with 1 groove on S. face and 4 grooves on E. face.</p> <p>At the corner point</p> <p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p> <div style="text-align: center;"> <p>T39N R50E S 29 S 28 S 32 S 33</p> </div> <p style="text-align: center;">1971</p> <p>deposit the original cornerstone and set a steel fence post, 6 ft. long, alongside the iron post and raise a mound of stone, 4 ft. base, 3 ft. high, W. of cor.</p> <p>From this corner, the cor. of secs. 27, 28, 33 and 34, hereinbefore described, bears S. 89° 38' E., 80.16 chs. dist. There is no remaining evidence of the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 28 and 33.</p> <p>N. 0° 19' W., bet. secs. 28 and 29.</p> <p>Over mountainous land, covered with sagebrush and bunchgrass; asc. 90 ft. over W. slope.</p>
