CHAINS

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land within Township 39 North, Range 50 East, ranges from about 6,000 to 7,300 ft. above sea level, and is rolling in the southern portion to mountainous in the north. The soil is rocky to a decomposed granite. The vegetation consists of sagebrush, greasewood and native grasses. There are some aspens on the north slopes of the higher elevations.

The township is drained by numerous creeks, the main ones being Berry Creek, Nelson Creek, Lewis Creek and Willow Creek. The Midas-Tuscarora Road traverses the township through the south tier of sections.

Principal users of the area are cattlemen. Access into the township is provided by numerous trail roads.
